Question #1:

Is there a specific "brand" for point of reference/sample other than properties and conditions it must meet?

County's Response:

Question #2:

What product are you currently using?

County's Response:

The County is currently using Fleetguard ES Compleat Organic Acid Technology (OAT) Antifreeze/Coolant (1-gallon jugs). This information is provided as an example of what the County is using now. Bidders are not required to bid Fleetguard and may offer an equal product. However, the coolant offered by the bidder must comply with the specifications described in this RFB. Please submit specifications of the product you are offering. This information should be uploaded with the Safety Data Sheet in item #6 under the Vendor Submissions section.

Question #3:

Can you advise what price per gallon you are currently paying?

County's Response:

The County has not been purchasing bulk red coolant.

Question #4:

What does a typical order quantity look like?

County's Response:

No accurate usage records exist to provide this information because the County has not been purchasing bulk red coolant. The County has been purchasing red coolant in 1-gallon containers on an as-needed basis. The County has approximately six hundred (600) fleet units with Cummins engines with plans to convert up to a total of 1,000 fleet units to red coolant over the next few years.
